### **PREVENT Duty Referral Protocol**

## **Church Lawton School PREVENT Duty Referral Protocol**

STEP 1	Staff record concerns on CPOMS as with any safeguarding
STEP 2	The Designated Safeguarding Lead or their Deputy will seek advice from CHECS, CHAD or SCiES and, if necessary, assess the risk further using the CSE Tool. Parents' views would also be added to the document.

STEP 3	If CSE tool highlights areas of concern, Cheshire East Consultation Team may request a PREVENT referral form be completed by DSL or DDSL: <a href="https://childrenandfamiliesportal.cheshireeast.gov.uk/web/portal/pages/childrenspreventreferral#h1">https://childrenandfamiliesportal.cheshireeast.gov.uk/web/portal/pages/childrenspreventreferral#h1</a> A copy of this form will also (automatically) be sent to prevent@merseyside.pnn.police.uk
STEP 4	After consideration, if warranted, the Local Authority pass the referral to the Channel coordinator for management through to the Local Authority Channel panel.  The Channel panel will consider support options.
